

have accordingly laid it out as shown by the accompanying map of the surveyor. By this it will appear that this road is a straight line commencing about $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile above the Pot House on the road leading from Middleburg to Union and running straight into and connecting at a point known as Mrs Adams Lane. (a County road)

We find that no yard, garden, or orchard, or any part thereof will have to be taken
